If you fail to pay your water bill on or before close of business on the twenty fifth day of the month (or next business day if the twenty fifth falls on Saturday, Sunday or holiday), a late fee of \$5.00 or 5% whichever, is greater will be assessed the following business day and shall be reflected on the next utility statement.
8.	Protect your water heater from Thermal Expansion: without a functioning Temperature & Pressure Relief Valve, your water heater can explode. Protection from thermal expansion is provided in a plumbing system by the installation of a thermal expansion tank in the hot water system piping downstream of the hot water tank and a temperature and pressure relief valve (T & P Valve) at the top of the tank. The thermal expansion tank controls the increased pressure generated within the normal operating temperature range of the water heater. The small tank with a sealed compressible air cushion provides a space to store and hold the additional expanded water volume.
	<ul> <li>What you should do to ensure protection from Thermal Expansion:</li> <li>a. You should check to see that an expansion tank and T &amp; P Valve are in place. If there is any doubt, you should contact a licensed plumber.</li> <li>b. The T &amp; P Valve should be periodically inspected to ensure that it is properly operating. Some T &amp; P Valves are equipped with a test level. Manually lifting the lever unseats the valve, allowing water to discharge. If water continues to leak from the T &amp; P Valve after closing, the valve may need to be replaced. A drain line must be installed to avoid water damage and scalding injury when the valve operates.</li> <li>c. The T &amp; P Valve should be periodically removed and visually inspected for corrosion deposits and to insure it has not be improperly altered or repaired.</li> <li>d. The above work can best be done by licensed plumber.</li> </ul>
