- You will be responsible to install and buy all materials needed for sub-division or extension of waterline. You will also be responsible for the hot tap to our main waterline.
 1. The materials will need to be approved by JWID Water System Manager.
- You will be responsible for any damages incurred during construction.
- You will need to have the Water System Manager inspect all waterlines, valves and fire hydrants before they are covered up.
- Pressure testing, compaction inspection testing, and bacteriological testing of the new facilities will be performed on all new Extensions of Waterlines and all Sub-Divisions.
 1. The chlorine shall be left in the pipe for at least 24 hours. You will need to flush the chlorine out thoroughly until clear water is obtained from existing system. Samples will be collected from prescribed sample points, preferably every 1000 feet length of pipe, all dead ends, and blow-off, if any.
 2. You will need to do a Pressure test
 3. If the samples are found to be **POSITIVE** more than twice, re-chlorinate the water line again.
 4. After the residual results are acceptable and passed off by the JWID Water System Manager the new water line is now ready to be **PLACED IN SERVICE.**

JWID Responsibility:

- To install Meter Box, Meter, MXU and foam pad.
- The Water System Manager will inspect all lines in a sub-division or extension of waterlines before they are covered.
